



NOTICE OF RACE

2011 FWBC Club J/22 Wednesday Night Series

INVITATION

You are cordially invited to compete in the J/22 Wednesday Night Series. Racing will take place on Eagle Mountain Lake typically just in front of the boat dock.

RULES

The races will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing for 2009-2012* and by the *Addendum* for the J/22 Fleet.

ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION

Each skipper must have a sign out card on file with the Harbor Master. The Weekly Drawing System will be used. Skippers may register by contacting the FWBC office prior to 4:00 PM on the Monday prior to each race. If there are more skippers than boats when the drawing is held, skippers that did not get a boat for that week will be notified by the office. If there are fewer skippers than boats when the drawing is held, the remaining boats will be available on a first come, first served basis. Skippers' accounts will be charged \$10 for each evening that they draw a boat up to a maximum of \$40 per series.

If a skipper registers and is not assigned a boat (i.e. draws out), that same skipper shall not be drawn out again until all skippers registered for a given race have drawn out. If all skippers registered have drawn out once, the same procedure shall be applied for the second draw out.

SCHEDULE

<i>Early Summer Series</i>	April 13, 20, 27, May 4, 11, 18
<i>Mid Summer Series</i>	May 25, June 1, 8, 15, 22, 29
<i>Heatstroke Series</i>	July 6, 13, 20, 27, August 3, 10, 17
<i>Final Series</i>	August 24, 31, September 7, 14, 21, 28, October 5

The warning signal will be at 6:30 PM. Up to two races per day will be held. The warning signal will be moved up to 6:00 PM for the *Final Series* for more daylight.

CLASS FLAG

The class flag shall be a yellow shape, unless other fleets are practicing on our course.

SCORING

The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply. Each series may consist of as many as 14 races.

If 11-14 races are completed, there will be 4 throwouts.

If 8-10 races are completed, there will be 3 throwouts.

If 5-7 races are completed, there will be 2 throwouts.

If 4 races are completed, there will be 1 throwout.

If less than 4 races are completed, there will be no throwouts.

If a skipper registers and is not assigned a boat (i.e. "draws out"), for those races, the skipper shall be scored the average of his/her scores in all the races in that series excluding throwouts.

A skipper that does not start, does not finish, retires after finishing, or was disqualified shall be scored 11 points (one more than the total possible numbers of boats). This changes Rules A4.2 and A9.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded based on the number of competitors and our budget.
